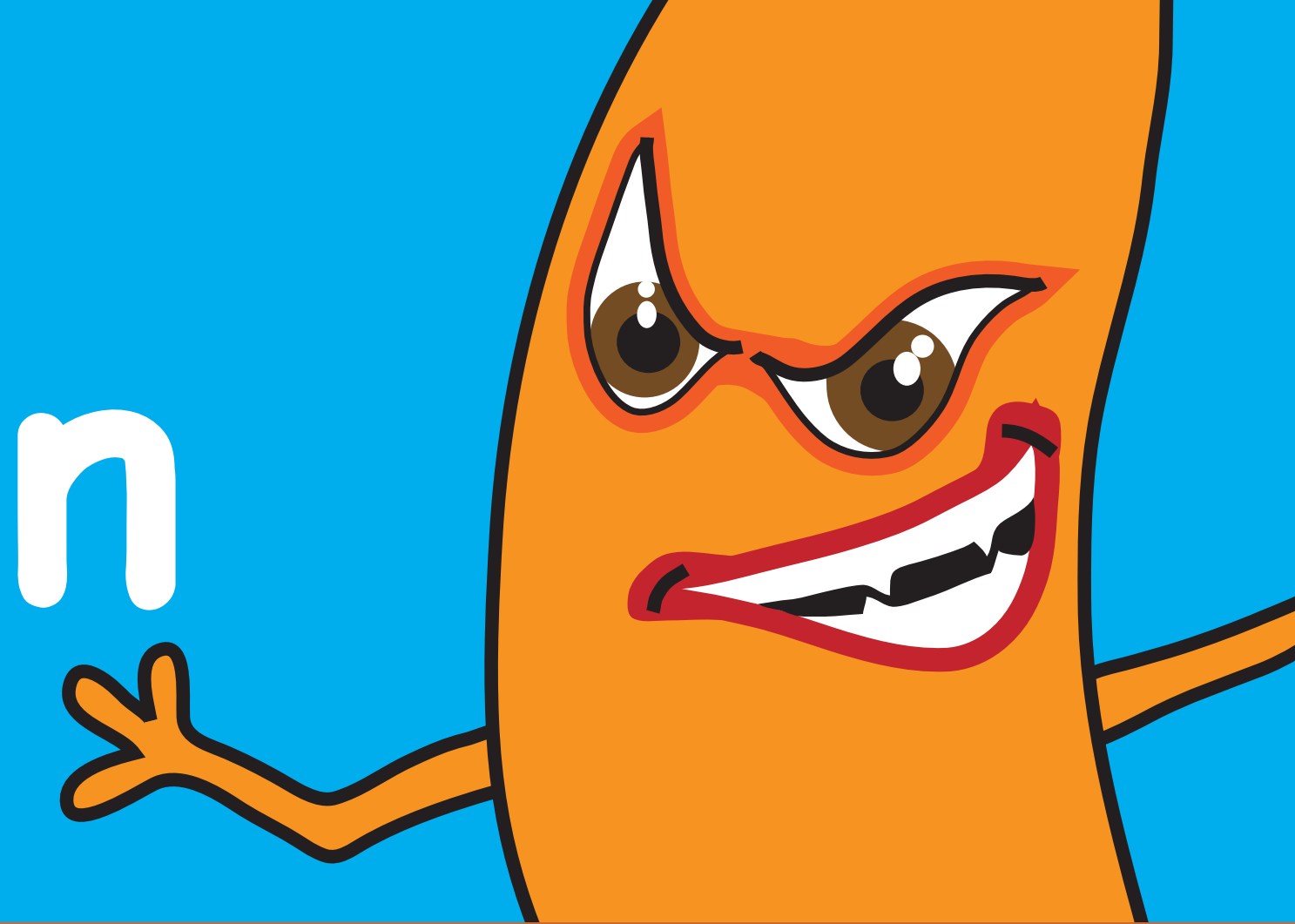


Prevention of *Toxoplasma* Infection



The risk of *Toxoplasma* infection can be reduced with these precautions;

- Do not eat raw or undercooked meat
- Wash your hands and any kitchen utensils after handling raw meat
- Wash all raw fruit and vegetables
- Wear gloves and wash your hands after gardening and emptying cat litter trays
- Avoid feeding your cat raw or undercooked meat
- Keep sandpits covered to keep cats out
- Keep cats out of animal feed bins
