

# How Moredun scientists find worm eggs

Parasite worm eggs are found in sheep poo. By **collecting** the eggs and **looking** at them, or allowing them to hatch, we can **discover** what kind of worms the sheep has living inside them.

Here's how we do it...

- We **collect** some sheep poo into a poly bag.
- We **mash** the poo with some water to make it runny.
- We **sieve** the poo to get rid of all the big bits of material.
- We **collect** the worm eggs from the sieve.
- We **look** at the worm eggs using a microscope.
